

Together, the paintings are filled with light and enhanced with the deepest darks. They explode with brilliant color, balanced with nuanced neutrals.




BEST OF SHOW




FIRST PLACE




SECOND PLACE

> This LITTLE piece has a BIG impact. The control over values is just beautiful. Lovely draftsmanship, and the viewer gets to wonder what this young man is thinking.




> Glorious, gestural, ethereal, beautiful. Just an honest moment in time.
